

2023-2024 New Student Enrollment

• Online admissions for **NEW applicants** is **ongoing** for the 2023-2024 school year! *If you have a child that does not currently attend GSCS, but is interested in attending GSCS for the 2023-2024 school year, <u>please submit their application as soon as possible as we have limited availability in some grade levels.</u>*

Existing school families will login to their <u>Family Portal account</u>, go to Apply/Enroll, then *Create a New Application*.

New families will go to the <u>Apply Online</u> button under <u>Admissions</u> on the school website: **www.goodshepherd.org**.

• Re-enrollment for **EXISTING students** has ended. If you did not re-enroll your child, please contact Holly Finke to see if there are still openings in their 2023-2024 grade level. The re-enrollment fee is now \$250 per student.

Exciting News From Step Up for Students

Exciting news! Families with students utilizing an FTC/FES-EO or FES-UA scholarship in the current school year may NOW renew their student's scholarship for the 2023-24 school year.

Step Up For Students has begun notifying renewal families that it is time to complete their renewal application. To prevent systems from becoming overloaded, notifications will continue to renewal families over the next week. The emails will include a link to EMA (Education Market Assistant), our new scholarship management platform. For families who have not yet been notified, please ask them to continue to monitor their email.

Reminders:

- Students utilizing a scholarship in the current school year may be automatically awarded a scholarship for the 2023-24 school year and will have funding priority, after the renewal application process is completed.
- A school should <u>not</u> create a student's EMA account, complete a student's scholarship application, submit documentation, or otherwise act on behalf of the parent/guardian. Doing so may result in the loss of the school's participation and/or scholarship eligibility and funding for the student.

IMPORTANT FOR RENEWAL FAMILIES:

- The "FIND STUDENTS" tool must be used to connect renewal students to their EMA account. If a renewal family cannot find their renewal student using the "FIND STUDENTS" tool, the family should **STOP** the application process and contact Step Up for support. Renewal students should NOT be added as a new student. Adding currently funded students as new students will delay 2023-24 funding.
 - When renewing a student's scholarship, the family may also apply for any additional students
 they'd like to have considered for an FES-UA or FTC/FES-EO Scholarship. To add **NEW** students (a
 student who is not using a scholarship for the 2022-23 school year), families should use the "ADD
 A STUDENT" button.



- Please strongly encourage your families to use the resources included in their email which will guide them through the process.
- Supporting documents will be requested when submitting their application. Please <u>click here</u> for more information on required documents.
- To manage their 2022-23 scholarship, renewal families will continue to use the same portal they have been using all year.

If a family is experiencing trouble linking their renewal student or adding their new student, please provide them this link for support.

New families will be able to apply in the very near future. Please encourage families to visit www.StepUpForStudents.org to sign up for the appropriate interest list and be notified when it's time to apply.




