Good Shepherd Catholic School will hold Orientation on Tuesday, August 8th for children entering Infants - 8th grade. Please attend at the above times based on your child's last name. Orientation will start in the Family Center (building next to GS Church) where you will find your child's homeroom assignment at the Student Services table. There will be other informational tables (see list below) along with bookstore items (journals and planners) and used uniforms for purchase using a FACTS Tuition Account authorization forms.

- Student Services Student Homeroom Assignments
- GS Parish Faith Formation and Youth Ministry Informational Table
- GS Parish Events Informational Table
- **Medication Forms** if your child requires medications dispensed during the school day, you must complete a Medical Consent Form and bring in the medication (required for both prescription and non-prescription medications). If your child requires an EpiPen for allergic reactions it must be received and the form completed prior to the first day of school.
- Extended Care Registration & FACTS Tuition if you child needs before or after care, you
 must register for the GSCS Extended Care program. You will complete a FACTS Tuition
 Account Authorization form for the registration fee (\$35). You can also complete a Tuition
 Account Authorization form for the Annual Dress Down Days (\$10/year/child) and ask questions about your FACTS tuition account.
- **Home & School Association** learn about various HSA (Parent-School Association) sponsored events along with where and how to volunteer throughout the school year.
- **Bookstore Items** items available for purchase using FACTS Tuition Account Authorization form, such as journals and planners that are part of your child's the supply list.
- **Used Uniforms** up to 2 sets of used uniforms per child can be purchased using a FACTS Tuition Account Authorization form.
- Maschio's Lunch Program learn about our hot lunch program for grade levels K-8th and how to create your child's lunch account that can be replenished online.

After completing your round of the Family Center, you and your child can visit their homeroom, meet their teacher and drop off supplies. We ask that you complete the family center and class-room visits within the allotted two hours by your child's last name, so that our teachers and staff can have a short break in-between sessions. We look forward to a great 2023-2024 school year!





Exciting News From Step Up for Students

Exciting news! Families with students utilizing an FTC/FES-EO or FES-UA scholarship in the current school year may NOW renew their student's scholarship for the 2023-24 school year.

Step Up For Students has begun notifying renewal families that it is time to complete their renewal application. To prevent systems from becoming overloaded, notifications will continue to renewal families over the next week. The emails will include a link to EMA (Education Market Assistant), our new scholarship management platform. For families who have not yet been notified, please ask them to continue to monitor their email.

Reminders:

- Students utilizing a scholarship in the current school year may be automatically awarded a scholarship for the 2023-24 school year and will have funding priority, after the renewal application process is completed.
- A school should <u>not</u> create a student's EMA account, complete a student's scholarship application, submit documentation, or otherwise act on behalf of the parent/guardian. Doing so may result in the loss of the school's participation and/or scholarship eligibility and funding for the student.

IMPORTANT FOR RENEWAL FAMILIES:

- The "FIND STUDENTS" tool must be used to connect renewal students to their EMA account. If a renewal family cannot find their renewal student using the "FIND STUDENTS" tool, the family should **STOP** the application process and contact Step Up for support. Renewal students should NOT be added as a new student. Adding currently funded students as new students will delay 2023-24 funding.
 - When renewing a student's scholarship, the family may also apply for any additional students
 they'd like to have considered for an FES-UA or FTC/FES-EO Scholarship. To add NEW students (a
 student who is not using a scholarship for the 2022-23 school year), families should use the "ADD
 A STUDENT" button.



- Please strongly encourage your families to use the resources included in their email which will guide them through the process.
- Supporting documents will be requested when submitting their application. Please <u>click here</u> for more information on required documents.
- To manage their 2022-23 scholarship, renewal families will continue to use the same portal they have been using all year.


If a family is experiencing trouble linking their renewal student or adding their new student, please provide them this link for support.
