Scientifically based and ethically-directed from our faith, *Play Like a Champion* designs its educational programs to promote children's physical, social, emotional and moral development to last a lifetime.

<u>All who want to coach (assistant or head) or plan to coach CYS middle school</u> sports must attend a Coach workshop. We also encourage grade school coaches to attend the workshop.

Effective 2024-25 school year all middle school coaches must attend a PLCT Coach workshop to coach a Catholic school team.

Those who attend the upcoming workshop would be covered through the 2027-2028 school year.

The cost to attend is \$15.00/coach.


